UNDERSTANDING HARMONY IN NATURE

- Nature is the collection of units the air, soil, water, plants.
 tress, animals, birds, human beings and even things that are distant from us like the sun, the moon, other planets etc.
- Understanding harmony in nature means reagnizing that all plants
 of the natural world plants, animals, humans and environment
 are connected and dependent on each other.

FOUR ORDERS OF NATURE

All the things in nature can be devided into 4 orders.

- 1 Material Order (Padartha Awastha)
- 2 Plant/ Bio Order (Pran Awastha)
- 3 Animal Order (Jeev Awastha)
- (Gryan Awastha)

1 Material Order

- It includes non-living entities such as soil, metals, water, gases and celestial bodies like stars and planets.
- It is largest order of nature.

2 Plant Order

- It includes all forms of plants life such as Grass, Plants, trees, flowers, Fruits & huge forest which possess the quality of growth and decay.
- It is next largest order of nature.

3 Animal Order

- It composites all the animals and birds, characterized by consciousness and ability to move
- It is third largest order of nature.

4 Human Order

- It refers to human beings with their unique capacities for conciousness, recusoning and self-awareness.
- It is smallest order of nature.

INNATENESS IN ORDER OF NATURE

- Innateness refers to the natural or inherent qualities that define each order of nature and determine how they function.
- Each of the 4 orders Moterial, Plant, Animal 1 Humanhous its own specific innate characteristics that guide its existence and interaction with the world.

NATURAL CHARACTERISTICS OF 4 ORDERS OF NATURE

- When we look at different orders in nature, we find the each order has a certain value.
- This value is also referred to as 'natural characteristics'.

1 Moterial Order

- Composition and decomposition
- Entities comes together & Form bigger unit
- Bigger transform to smaller
- Soil Brick Tower : Composition
- Tower Full → Soil : Decomposition

2 Plant / Bio Order

- Composition & Decomposition + Nurture or Worsen
- Eat healthy fauits & Vegetables: Nurture the Body
- Eat Dhatura (Thom Apple): Worsen the Body

3 Animal Order

- Composition / Decomposition + Nurture / Worsen + Cruety / Non Cruety
- Cruetty: The feeling that it can fulfill it need through violence and force fulness e.g. Tigers, Lions are covel
- Non- cruelty: (ow / Groats are non crael.)

4 Human Order

- (omposition / Decomposition + Nurture / Worsen + Perseverance / Bravery / Generosity
- Perseverance (Dhirta): This means being committed to living in harmony
 at all levels of existence.
- Bravery (Virata): It involves being ready to help others to have night understanding of harmony and living at all 4 levels.
- Generosity (Udarta): It involves being ready to invest yourself, your body and wellth to help the other have the night understanding.

HUMAN BEINGS IN CURRENT SCENARIO

• Even through we have above natural characteristics, we are not living according to this.

• This is the basic reason for the contradiction and conflict that we see

in human being.

This is what leads to state of unhappiness.

 Only when, we start to live according to our basic human characteristics as mentioned above we can have harmony with rest of the nature.

INTERCONNECTEDNESS & MUTUAL FULFILLMENT AMONG 4 ORDERS OF NATURE

- In nature, everything is interconnected and works together to maintain balance and harmony.
- This concept is known as interconnectedness and mutual fulfillment cumong the 4 orders of nature.
- These 4 orders are:
- 1 Material Order
- 2 Plant Order
- 3 Animal Order
- 4 Human Order

1 MATERIAL ORDER & PLANT ORDER


Soil provides a foundation and nutrients for plants to grow. In return
plants help prevent soil exosion and contribute organic matter back
to soil, maintain O2 level in atmosphere.

2 MATERIAL, PLANT & ANIMAL ORDER

- Plants produce oxygen and serve as food for animals, while
 material order provide basts for movement of all animals, birds and
 fishes.
- In return animal order helps enrich soil its excreta & plant with pollination.

3 HUMAN AND REST OF THE ORDERS

- Each three orders fulfills human orders
- Human orders takes soil, minerals and metals from material order, but in return end up polluting the soil and resource depletion.
- Human order dependent on plant order for food but destroyed forest,
 multiple species of plant and herbs.
- Human dependent on animals to carry out production, transportation, milk, honey but in veturn he made them to extinct.
- Human order dependent on all other 3 orders but is not mutual
 fulfilling and this leads to problems such as pollution, resource depletion,
 extinction of animals, Global warming and threats to human race on
 earth.



RECYCLABILITY IN NATURE

- Recyclability means that materials are used over and over again, ensuring nothing is wasted for example, when plants and animals die composers like bacteria and fungi break them down into nutrients that enrich the soil, these nutrients are then absorbed by new plants, continuing the cycle of life.
- Similiarly, water continuously moves through the environment of cycle: It evaporates from surfaces forms clouds, and returns, as rain or snow ensuring that water is always available for living organisms.

SELF REGULATION IN NATURE

- In forest, the growth of trees takes places in a way so that the amount of soil, plants and animals remain conserved.
- · Nature keeps the population, proportion naturally maintained.
- In animals, the number of males and females generated through reproduction is such that the continuty of species is ensured by itself.
- This happens with humans too.
- But Inhuman practices have led to disproportionate numbers of men and women.

- Unit is any indivisual thing that has a specific form & takes up space.
- All the 4 orders of nature comes under the unit.

- (4) Human Order


SPACE
